a. Attendee List. The Exhibitor shall not use any personal information, including names, email addresses, mailing addresses or any other information obtained from the event's attendee list circulated among or otherwise generally made available to the event's attendees (the "Attendee List") for any purpose. b. Data Protection Laws. d. International Transfers. f. Indemnification. The Exhibitor shall defend, hold harmless, and indemnify PDA as to any third party's claims, actions, investigations, or other proceedings and related damages, injuries, awards, or other liabilities in connection with the Exhibitor's violations of its obligations under this Section 18 (Attendee Data -EEA).
