Submitters will be advised in writing of the status of their abstract after **May 31, 2019**. To take advantage of early bird registration and be listed in the online program agenda, poster presenters are required to register as a <u>paid full conference</u> attendee by **August 9, 2019** at the rate of \$2,195 member/\$2,474 nonmember. **Companies with multiple accepted abstracts are required to register a different individual for each display at the <u>paid full conference</u> rate. Only one presentation per individual will be accepted.**

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS: Registrations included with exhibitor booth packages are not eligible to present. Exhibitors that plan to present a poster must register as a paid full conference attendee.
